## SFCP CELEBRATION! VIDEO/BEST PRACTICE GUIDELINES

Included with this NewsBrief is the 'Best Practice Form' from the SFCP District Core Team Celebration Committee. Please complete this form and send it, along with a 30-45 second video clip or 4-6 still shots of your school's 'best practice', to Karen Currier at Ranchview Elementary by March 15, 2004.

Karen's team will then create a video/CD of all 21 schools' Best Practices and show it at the May 8<sup>th</sup> Celebration Breakfast. The 'Best Practice' forms from all 21 schools will also be submitted to the National Network of Partnership Schools for possible inclusion in their annual <u>Promising Partnership Practices</u> book. Last year <u>eight D203</u> schools were recognized nationally!!!

**Don't panic!!!** This isn't the Academy Awards and Hollywood producers we're not! Plus the Best Practice form is essentially the same as last year. Listed below are steps to get you through this process:

- Decide on your school's Best Practice and 'capture' it in 4-6 still camera shots or a 30-45 second video clip **45 seconds max**. You may include an interview or voiceover.
- You may edit your own tape or submit raw footage if doing the latter, indicate the exact location of the segment of tape you want included by the time code indicators.
- Your school's TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION SPECIALISTS are available to help you.
- Our team will then take care of editing, adding subtitles and musical background and compiling all the still shots and video clips into one video celebration of your great work.
