All summer school classes will begin on Monday, June 13 and end Friday, July 8.
No classes will be held on Monday, July 4th.

Classes will meet at Washington Junior High School, located at 201 North Washington Street.

Course offerings are listed on the back.

All classes will meet for one hour each day.

Session One is from 8:30 to 9:30 a.m.

Session Two is from 9:30 to 10:30 a.m.

Session Three is from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m.

Three different courses will be offered each session.

You may select one course per session, up to a total of 3 courses for the morning.

Enrollment confirmation will be sent via U.S. mail by June 6, 2005.

The 2005 Summer School Program is offered on a tuition basis only for all courses.

Tuition will be \$100.00 for each four week course.

Out-of-District non-resident tuition will be \$120.00 for each course.

Please complete and mail the enclosed enrollment form with fee payment no later than May 20, 2005.

A non-refundable cancellation fee of \$25 will be charged for students canceling registration after June 13, 2005.

NO REFUNDS will be granted after June 20, 2005.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

DEVELOPMENTAL READING/LANGUAGE ARTS

One Hour Session

4 Week Course

Tuition: \$100.00

This course identifies weaknesses and provides instruction in reading and writing for students performing below grade level. It focuses on improving reading strategies and comprehension skills as well as accuracy and fluency. It is designed for students who have completed grades 6, 7, or 8.

STUDY SKILLS

One Hour Session

4 Week Course

Tuition: \$100.00

This course will focus on the skills of listening, note taking, following directions, and test taking. Emphasis will be placed on the basic organizational skills that facilitate the development of student responsibility. It is designed for students who have completed grades 6, 7, or 8.

6th GRADE MATHEMATICS

One Hour Session

4 Week Course

Tuition: \$100.00

This course, **for students who have completed 6th grade**, analyzes the student's present performance in the Math Thematics program and provides instruction in basic computation, fractions, decimals, percents, measurement, and problem solving. This class is designed for students with below-average skills in math who need reinforcement before entering the Math Thematics 7th grade program.

7th GRADE MATHEMATICS

One Hour Session

4 Week Course

Tuition: \$100.00

This course, **for students who have completed 7th grade**, analyzes the student's present performance in the Math Thematics program and provides instruction in the focus areas of geometry, probability, and statistics. This class is designed for students who need reinforcement of 7th grade math concepts before entering the Connected Mathematics 8th grade program.

8th GRADE MATHEMATICS

One Hour Session

4 Week Course

Tuition: \$100.00

This course, **for students who have completed 8th grade**, is designed to review fundamental skills of algebra and number theory as presented in the Connected Mathematics program. This class is intended for students who want to expand their mathematics background prior to entering high school.
