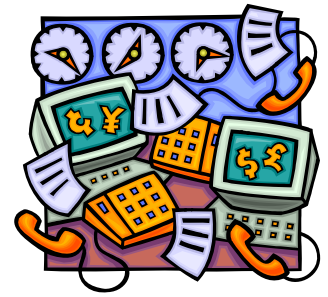


Dear Parents:

In an effort to provide additional opportunities for those students desiring an extension of the school year, we are offering a new junior high summer school program this year entitled, **Technology Camp – A World in Motion.**

The camp will meet four days per week: July 11- 14 and July 18-21



Classes will meet at Washington Junior High School, located at 201 North Washington Street.

### **Technology Camp – A World in Motion**

#### **Three Hour Session**

This course, **for students who have completed 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, or 7<sup>th</sup> grades**, is designed for students and teachers to participate together in an exciting curriculum unit. **A World in Motion** introduces young students to the excitement of learning math, science, engineering, and technology concepts in the context of an authentic engineering design experience. The students explore forces of motion with the aid of technology tools and create a presentation to share their findings. Students choose one of the two options below. Students will work in flexible groups of about 3.

Students attend four days per week for three hour a day (8:00 – 11:00)

### **2 Week Course**

**Tuition: \$150.00**

#### **Week 1: July 11- 14**

- All students work in groups on the 1<sup>st</sup> activity (Skimmer), they then regroup and select from selected activities for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> explorations.
- Use tech tools to record data, procedures, and observations
- Excel ~ CBL ~ Video & Still Cameras ~ Blackboard (Group reflections and sharing)

#### **Week 2: July 18-21**

- Students select a Scientific principle for further exploration and for reporting on
- “What scientific principles did you work with in your experiments?”
- “How can you help us teach students about a scientific principle of your choice?”
