

## Final Research Project Web Site

Your final project for Weighted Essay Writing will be a term paper. As you are working on your paper you will also create a web site based upon the content of your paper. Instructions will be provide in how to take the content of your paper and transform it into a web site.

All of the specific elements of your paper must be included in your web presentation. These include:

- Active voice
- Debate format including the:
  - opening or introduction
  - thesis statement
  - refutation (with a minimum of three reasons)
  - support (with a minimum of three reasons)
  - conclusion or call to action
- One complex graph or table (minimum)
- In-text documentation
- Annotated Works Cited

*You will NOT need to identify vocabulary words on the web site as you do in your paper.*

In addition, your web site must also incorporate the following features or capabilities:

- At least **one** illustrative or decorative graphic which directly relates to your topic or a specific point within a sub topic (and not the complex graph/table or any background image)
- A minimum of **one** to a maximum of **five** “outside” links to relevant web sites (One link must be included in your conclusion or “Call to Action”).
- Navigation links between your pages
- All pages must link back to the index page **and to the** Project index page <<http://www.ncusd203.org/central/html/what/commarks/torsbergweb/>>.
- Author(s) of the site (a pseudonym may be used with teacher approval)
- Creation date and/or “last updated” dates
- A feedback link (e-mail link to author(s) or webmaster) <[webnchs@ncusd203.org](mailto:webnchs@ncusd203.org)>
- Correct grammar and spelling
- Active Links to works cited which are found on the Internet

The point of the web site is to communicate the substance of your term paper without posting the term paper. You may utilize portions of your paper, but you should not include the entire contents of your paper – just the essential information and arguments. These need to be presented in a visually appealing manner. Your use of space, text, and graphics will be as essential to a good grade as the content of your words.
