



SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST MAPLEBROOK SCHOOL 2004-2005

Maplebrook Home and School Association will once again sponsor the annual "Maplebrook Mall" on Thursday, August 19th from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The mall offers families an opportunity to purchase all the school supplies that will be needed for the coming school year. Although parents can opt to shop for items at local retail stores, there are some items that are only available for purchase through the Mall.

This month (May) we are accepting pre-orders for full supply kits. The kits contain all of the supplies needed for a particular grade except for items that are optional or marked with an asterisk. Pre-orders can be picked up the day of the Mall. Before sending the supplies to school, label all supplies for 2nd thru 5th grades. **Do NOT label supplies for kindergarten and first grade, as the supplies will be pooled.**

Your child(ren) will find it beneficial to have all of the supplies at the beginning of the school year. As supplies are depleted, teachers will request replacement. For your convenience, replacement supplies will be available at the school store, open each Wednesday, during lunchtime. The school store will also be open the first 2 days of school (8:20am – 9:00am), if you are unable to attend the Mall.

A few reminders:

- Maplebrook encourages the use of reusable lunch bags (not sold at the mall).
- Items marked with a " * " are not available at the mall.
- In the event we sell out of an item, we will gladly reorder and deliver it to your child's classroom.
- 3rd graders use recorders only; 4th and 5th graders need a recorder and a book. They can use the same recorder for all 3 years and the book for two years; used books and recorder are acceptable if they are in good shape.
- Used clipboards, scissors, rulers, goggles, or other items in good shape are welcome, as well.
