School, Family, Community Partnership

School, Family, Community Partnership is part of Beebe's Home and School Association and is responsible for offering programs that support Beebe's School Improvement Plan and involve families and the community to contribute to student achievement and success.

Family Connections – Family Connections is a group of Beebe families ready and willing to help other Beebe families in times of crisis or need. Volunteer names will be added to an e-mail list and will be contacted when a family's need is brought to the attention of Beebe staff. Volunteers and recipients will remain anonymous.

Ice Cream Social – Volunteers are needed during the evening of the Ice Cream Social to help serve ice cream, take tickets or donations, clean-up, etc.. This event will be held in late May.

New Family Welcome Committee - Team members will help welcome new families to Beebe by providing information and acting as a point of contact for new families as questions or concerns arise.

Read Naturally – Read Naturally is an ongoing reading program to tutor Beebe students in reading fluency. Volunteer tutors spend approximately 1-1.5 hours per week with 5-6 children from one classroom working on building reading fluency. Training is provided.

School-wide Survey – Volunteers are asked to help distribute and tally the school-wide survey usually distributed in the Spring.

Turn Off the TV Week – Volunteers are needed to help plan evening activities during the week long event held at the end of April. A team of at least two people will help plan and run one of the four events during the week.
